

## NORTH BONNEVILLE HERITAGE TRAILS

North Bonneville's city pathway system is unique among Washington towns. Each of the four Heritage Trails originates at the downtown station, each coinciding with a different geographical feature of the area.

Each trail is color-coded. See legend below.

## BEACON ROCK & HAMILTON MOUNTAIN

848-foot Beacon Rock, 3 miles west of North Bonneville, is the world's second largest monolith. Hamilton Mountain, just west of town, boasts great views from its 2400 foot summit.

## BONNEVILLE DAM

Bonneville Dam consists of several dam structures that together complete a span of the Columbia River between Washington and Oregon.
